What happens in the Vancouver Museum after dark? Stories to chill your spine - *The 15th Annual Haunted Vancouver Trolley Tour October 12-31, 2007*

Vancouver, BC - October 4, 2007 - Are you brave enough to look into the mirror of Elizabeth Bathory, the infamous Blood Countess? Is this axe the very weapon that relieved Vlad the Impaler of his head in 1476? Rumour has it that several of these artefacts are haunted by agitated spirits. Guests beware! The ghosts of the past don't always rest easy!

This year the Vancouver Museum presents a ghoulish gallery of grisly offerings and artefacts gathered from around the globe in its 15th Annual Haunted Vancouver Trolley Tour. Guests are invited to wander between the relics, some of which have been linked with the most notorious figures in history!

Then, hop on the trolley and hear stories of eerie spirit sightings and tales of Vancouver's most infamous murders and hauntings. Visit Mountain View Cemetery, home to 92,000 grave sites and 145,000 interred remains and the Old City Morgue, to witness an autopsy.

Tours depart between 6 - 9:20pm and are 2 hrs long. They start and end at the Vancouver Museum, 1100 Chestnut Street. Visitors should be here 15 minutes prior to their tour. Free Parking
